**Prerequisites:** Math 141 and 142, or College Algebra and Trigonometry with grades of C or better.

**Textbook:** *Calculus*, ninth edition, by Larson, Edwards.

**Materials:** Pencil, paper, textbook and a scientific calculator are required for the course. You will also need graph paper. Only work in pencil is allowed on exams. Points will be deducted for using pen.

**SLOs:**

1. Given an algebraic or transcendental function, the student will be able to correctly find a limit of the function with 65% accuracy.
2. Given an algebraic or transcendental function, the student will be able to correctly take the derivative of the function with 65% accuracy.
3. Given an algebraic or transcendental function, the student will be able to correctly find the antiderivative of the function with 65% accuracy.

**Attendance:** Attendance at each class meeting is expected. It is the student's responsibility to sign in on the roll sheet. A student may be dropped for more than 2 absences.

4. HW points are also 4 points of your test or quiz grade total.

**Quizzes:** There are six quizzes worth 20 points each. Quiz problems will be similar to those in the homework. Once during the semester, if you miss a quiz, you may make it up during my office hours. If you miss a second quiz, you will receive a score of 0. Remember, your homework points determine if your quizzes will be graded using partial credit or not. All quizzes count...NO SCORES ARE DROPPED.

**Exams:** There are five exams worth 100 points each. Exam problems will be similar to those in the homework. Once during the semester, if you miss an exam, you may make it up during my office hours. If you miss a second exam, you will receive a score of 0. Remember, your homework points determine if your exams will be graded using partial credit or not. All exams count...NO SCORES ARE DROPPED.

**Final Exam:** **All students are required to take the final exam at the scheduled time.** Bring Scantron form 882-E, and your pencils, scratch paper, and scientific calculator.
